

Marina Housing launched a product line for 2009

Marina Housing has launched its product line for 2009, which consists of four floating houses of different sizes and styles, marina office and service buildings and a floating boatshed.

Marina Housing builds floating houses and other floating solutions. Marina Housing products are ready planned turn-key packages that are ex-works ready in 15 weeks from the ordering. A Marina Housing product always includes a house, concrete pontoons and standard seaflex anchoring (excluding boatshed which includes standard chain anchoring). Marina Housing products are all designed according to European building norms (EN).

Marina Housing product line includes four floating homes. Archipelago Villa 90 is a modern loft house, inspired by North-European boatsheds. The architecture of Four Season Villa 101 is modern and the dominating feature is the large roof terrace. There are two Summer Bungalows in the product line. In Summer Bungalow 42 two sleeping cabins, living room and bathroom form a compact yet functional package. The bigger one Summer Bungalow 65 is a fully equipped one storey floating villa.

In addition to floating homes the Marina Housing product line includes Marina Office and Marina Service Buildings, which have sauna facilities with a lounge and a meeting room and harbor master office to serve the users of the marina. The buildings can be placed to a marina together or separately. A floating boatshed is also a part of the product line.

The Marina Housing products are designed for Northern-European weather conditions but they can also be upgraded to suite differing conditions. In addition to the product line Marina Housing also designs and builds case-specific unique floating solutions.
